- Item 1. Throughout: Remove "No." before 26 when referring to Multiple District 26. (i.e., Multiple District No. 26) Justification: Continuity and clarity.

Justification: Clarity of intent, Correct grammar; Conform to established literary format.

- Item 3. Constitution Article VII Section 1. Delete entire section; replace with "The Convention site shall be determined in accordance with the Policy Manual in effect at the time."
 Justification: Simplify State Convention planning.
- Item 4. Constitution Article VIII (New), Sec 5, (p) {new} and Sec 7 (d); Add Investment Committee. Justification: Update financial accountability/responsibility.
- Item 5. Constitution Article VIII (New), Sec 14; Move GAT (GAT, GMT, GST) from Constitution to By-Laws; reword to LCI model language.

Justification: Comply with LCI Model

- Item 6. Constitution Article X, Sec 1; additional clarification of Convention Site selection. Justification: Comply with LCI directives.
- Item 7. Move "Election Procedures" from Constitution to By-Laws as Article I, Section 8.
 Justification: Comply with LCI Model
- Item 8. Constitution Article XIII (New); Remove current Section 1, renumber following Sections. Justification: Covered by Automatic Update section in Amendments (Article XIV {new}).
- Item 9. Constitution Article XIV (New), Sec. 3; reduce notice time. Justification: Comply with LCI change.
- Item 10. By-Laws Article I, Sec 8 (a), (b), (c); Election Procedures from Constitution. Justification: Comply with LCI Model
- Item 11. By-Laws Article III, Sec 3; Clarify/update duties of Council Secrtary-Treasurer. Justification: Conform to LCI Model.
- Item 12. By-Laws Article III, Sec 4. Defer details of duties of Protocol Chairperson to Policy Manual. Justification: Unique to Multiple District 26.
- Item 13. By-Laws Article III, Sec 7, 8, 9; Move GST, GMT and GLT from Constitution, reword to LCI Model. Justification: Conform to LCI Model.
- Item 14. By-Law Article VI, Sec 5; delete anticipated income from expenses allowed. Justification: Comply with LCI restrictions.
- Item 15. By-Laws Article VIII, Sec 1 (c) {old}; Delete reference to pro-rata tax for newly/reorganized clubs. Justification: Conform to revised LCI procedure.
- Item 16. By-Laws Article VIII, Sec 2 (c) {new}; Clarify fund disbursement procedure/signature requirement(s). Justification: Comply with LCI Model.
- Item 17. By-Laws, Article X, Section 3, Delete entire section; replace with "The Convention site shall be determined in accordance with the Policy Manual in effect at the time."
 Justification: Simplify State Convention planning.

Amendments Proposed to 2020 Document (if it had been approved).

Item 1.

Constitution, Article VII, Section 2. Council of Governors: (a) delete phrase "current or"

It shall also include one eurrent or past district governor

Reason: Additional qualification added by this multiple Multiple.

Item 2.

Constitution, Article VIII, Section 7. Miscellaneous Additional Provisions: Add new (d)

(d) All state-wide committees whose function involve the collection and disbursement of funds for any project approved by the State Council shall prepare and file with the State Council a complete financial report of their operations within thirty (30) days after the annual State Convention.

Reason: In La-5, inadvertently omitted from 2020 revision.

Item 3.

By-Laws, Article I - Delete in its entirety:

Reason: Covered by Constitution, Article VIII, Section 2, (g) Committee on International Candidates.

Item 4.

By-Laws, Article II – Delete in its entirety:

Reason: Covered by Constitution, Article VII, Section 2.

Item 5.

Renumber By-Laws Current Articles III-X to Articles I-VIII respectively.

Reason: Format

Item 6.

By-Laws Article III (new Article I), Section 3. (duties of) Multiple District Council Secretary-Treasurer: Replace current wording with LCI item La-5, omitting (g).

Section 3. MULTIPLE DISTRICT COUNCIL SECRETARY-TREASURER. Under the supervision and direction of the Council of Governors, the council secretary-treasurer shall:

- (a) Keep an accurate record of the proceedings of all meetings of the Council of Governors, and within ten (10) days after each meeting forward copies to all members of the Council of Governors, and the office of Lions Clubs International.
- (b) Assist the Council of Governors in conducting the business of the multiple district, and perform such other duties as are specified or implied in the constitution and by-laws, or as may be assigned to him/her from time to time by the Council of Governors.
- (c) Receive and give proper receipts for all dues and taxes required to be paid over to him/her by the sub-district cabinet secretary-treasurers, deposit the same in a bank or banks designated by the Council of Governors, and disburse the same under the supervision and control of the Council of Governors by checks drawn against said deposits signed by himself/herself and countersigned by the council chairperson or other duly authorized council member.
- (d) Keep accurate books and records of accounts and minutes of all Council of Governors and multiple district meetings, and permit inspection of the same by any member of the Council of Governors or any club in the multiple district (or any duly authorized agent of either) at any reasonable time for any proper purpose.
- (e) Secure bond for the faithful performance of his/her duties in such sum and with such sureties as may be required by the Council of Governors.
- (f) Deliver, in a timely manner, at the conclusion of his/her term in office, the general and/or financial accounts, funds and records of the multiple district to his/her successor in office.
- (g) In the event that separate offices of council secretary and council treasurer are adopted the duties herein are to be attributed to each of the officers according to the nature of the duties.

Reason: LCI wording which more clearly defines the duties of the position.

Item 7.

By-Laws Article III (new Article I), Section 7: Rename Section to Global Action Team (GAT); reformat current Sections 7 – 9 (GST), (GMT) and (GLT) as (a), (b) and (c). Renumber current Section 10 as 8.

- Section 7. Global Action Team (GAT) The GAT shall be composed of the Council Chair, who shall serve as chairperson, and all Global Team (GLT, GMT, GST) Multiple District Coordinators. The Multiple District GAT Coordinators shall be selected for a one-year term, and may serve multiple terms. Such Selection of the GAT Coordinators shall be made at the Council of Governors meeting prior to the state convention. Those Lions interested in seeking any of the positions shall submit a letter of intent to the council chair prior to the time for selecting the coordinators. The letter of intent may be sent by email, USPS, or personally to the chair. The council will not be responsible for failure of delivery. Descriptions and responsibilities of these positions are:
- (a) Global Service Team (GST) Multiple District Coordinator. The GST multiple district coordinator is a member of the Multiple District Global Action Team. His/her responsibilities include:
- (a) i Develop and execute an annual multiple district action plan and monitor progress toward goals. Support districts and offers motivation to reach district goals.etc.

Reason: GAT inadvertently omitted from 2020 revision.

Item 8.

By-Laws Article IV (new Article III), Section 1. Council Meetings: Delete in its entirety. Renumber remaining Sections accordingly.

Reason: Covered by Constitution, Article VII, Section 2, (f).

Item 9.

By-Laws Article VIII (new Article VI), Section 1, (c): Delete in its entirety.

(c) Disbursement therefrom shall be by checks drawn and signed by the council secretary treasurer and countersigned by the council chairperson.

Reason: Covered by By-Laws, Article 1, Section 5 above.

Item 10.

By-Laws, Article VIII (new Article VI), Section 5. This fund shall be used as defined in Article VIII, Section 2 (e) hereof. of the Constitution of this Multiple District 26.

Reason: Clarifies location of reference.

Item 11.

Make required Editorial/Format changes due to Article, Section and/or sub-paragraph revisions, and Adjust Table of Contents as required.





State Zoom Meeting Protocol

The Administrator for the State Zoom Account will be the Council Chairperson

- 1. The Zoom meetings must be signed up for, a Minimum of 10 days out, unless cleared by the Zoom Administrator.
- 2. The Committee Chairperson will Email the State Office, not the Administrator and request a ZOOM meeting to be set up by the Administrator @ missourilions@gmail.com.
- 3. The email should include, Requested Date and Time along with an optional Date and Time and who is the Committee Chairperson or the Lion in charge.
- 4. The State Office will check the calendar to see if the Date, the Time and the Administrator is available. If open, the Administrator will be emailed to set the meeting.
- 5. The Administrator, will try to make available times for Days, Nights & Weekends.
 - **Meeting Precedence is ... Council of Governors, State Office, State Committees, PIDs, Districts and Clubs; meetings may get bumped in order of precedence, if needed.
- 6. The Committee Chairperson or Lion in Charge will receive the Zoom link and the Invitation. Distribution of the Zoom link to be by the Committee.
- 7. The Administrator will start and end the meeting only, the Administrator will not monitor nor participate in the meeting.
- 8. The meeting will allow the committee to share screens with their participants.
- 9. Zoom Recordings of the meeting will be allowed, if requested, and the Administrator is available. Once recorded it will be sent to the Lion that called the meeting and then deleted from the State account in 3 days, no records will be kept by the State.
- 10. Anonymous Polling / Voting will be allowed, *if requested*, and the Administrator is available.
